Project Self-Sufficiency (PS-S) assists low-income, single parent families struggling to make ends meet and overcome the cycle of poverty.

Most single parents enrolled in the program upgrade their training or continue their education in order to dramatically increase their opportunity to earn a true living wage.

We are a local non-profit organization supported by United Way, local governments, and private funders. We do not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, gender, sexual orientation, gender expression, national origin, age or disability.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST:

- Be a Larimer County resident
- Live apart from a significant other
- Demonstrate a significant need for PS-S services
- Have at least one child aged 13 and under living with them at least 60% of the time
- Be a low-income single parent
- Consistently attend scheduled appointments
- Show willingness to work with a PS-S advisor

HOW WE HELP:

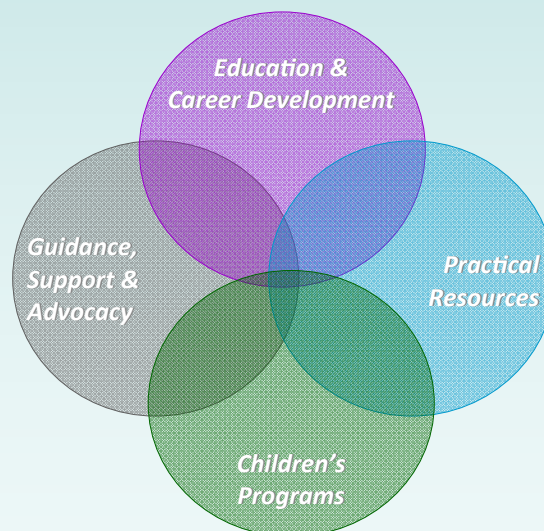
Participants receive support, guidance, information and help in securing the resources needed to meet their goals. (Some resources may be limited and access is contingent upon progress made in the PS-S program.)
