Direct Program Support Funds

Scholarship Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$85,000**

Join us in supporting the hardworking, single parents of PS-S who pursue additional education in order to better provide for their families and achieve economic independence.

Child Care Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$60,000**

Offset the high cost of childcare for our Participants. Child care is necessary as they pursue education and work experience towards the goal of a self-sufficient wage.

Transportation Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$45,000**
Value of Donated Vehicles: **\$75,000**

Drive PS-S Participants down the road to success with reliable transportation. Donated cars and funds for repairs allow participants to commute to work, school and child care while pursuing personal goals.

Housing Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$15,000**

Estimated annual need: **\$21,000**

Boundless Children's Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$18,000**

Mental Health Fund

Estimated annual need: **\$6,000**
